## **CLASSROOM BRIEFINGS**

CLASS	Grade 5	Grade 6	Grade 7	Grade 8
SCIENCE	Science 5 is learning about Classification Systems. We have just started studying the Animal Kingdom and the Invertebrates. They will also learn the major phyla of Vertebrates.  **A project will be assigned the 2nd week of March.	Science 6 is wrapping up Plate Tectonics. We are going to dive into studying Earthquakes and Volcanoes. It should be a booming and erupting time!	Science 7 is moving on to Newton's Laws of Motion. Science 7A is going to start a unit on Living Things. We will start with their needs, structural organization and will study the cells.	Grade 8 is just continuing their studies on the Human Body. Our newest topic is the Respiratory System. From there, we will explore the Excretory System.
MATH	Math 5 is working on Fractions, and operations associated with Fractions	Math 6th is working on equations, solving equations and inequalities.	Math 7 is completing their unit on Percents. Math 7a is working on probability and we are working on a project.	Math 8 is completing a unit on linear and non linear functions. Algebra 1 completed a unit on Statistics and we are now on Systems of Equations using many methods.

They will then begin an author research project which they will complete as a joint assignment in Technology and ELA.	6th Grade will continue learning how to analyze poetry and their final test will be early in the month. They will then begin an author research project which they will complete as a joint assignment in Technology and ELA.	7th Grade will continue working on their author research project and then present their research to the class as a PowerPoint Presentation. They will then begin a new novel study with accompanying writing activities.	8th Grade will continue working on their Animal Farm theme essays. These should be completed within the first week or two of the month. They will then begin an author research project which they will complete as a joint assignment in Technology and ELA.
SOCIAL STUDIES	5th grade will be wrapping up the Latin America Unit and moving on to the USA Government Unit. We have enjoyed our daily songs based on the countries in the Western Hemisphere!:)	6th grade has been working on the Ancient Greece Unit! We have created our own city-states and will be wrapping up the Unit on an activity on the gods/goddesse s! We will then move on to Ancient Rome!	7th grade is on the American Revolution Unit and we are loving it!! We are diving into the Declaration of Independence and focussing on the major events throughout the Revolution.	8th grade is moving closer to the 1900s, finishing up the Civil War and learning all about Reconstruction and the "New Nation". We will be looking into inventions during that time and how it has affected modern day life!
