## What Kind of Calculator do I Need for Middle School?

Students taking Math 6, 7, 7a or Math 8:

- You need a scientific calculator. I recommend these: The TI 30xii and Casio Fx300 which can be purchased at Walmart, Target, Amazon, and many area stores. The are typically under \$15 and can be used for all the above math classes. If you have yours from this year, no need to purchase again.







Students taking **Algebra 1.** These are students who have taken Math 7a, need a graphing calculator. This is required by NY State. I recommend TI 84 Graphing calculator that is the Color Edition, CE. This has many advantages and can be used for high school math classes. They are expensive, over \$100. But watch for sales, and students can often buy used on eBay. In the area, they can be found at Walmart, Target and Office Depot. Amazon sells them, and often Best Buy does as well.
