School glue materials in the shoebox. hand held hole punch 3. Check your student's pouch frequently and be sure he/she has the materials small scissors needed at all times. Do an inventory once a month. Be sure the pouch is not damaged. Color media (1 basic set of crayons or colored pencils, or low odor markers) 4. Bring 3 hole punched, lined paper to every class every day. Find a way to keep a small scissors supply in your locker for easy access. In most cases your teachers will set up folders 1 highlighter /binders that will contain the paper. Keep it supplied. Student and Parent are asked to CHECK the POUCH frequently. Repair, Replace, Sharpen before classes start. DO NOT OVERFILL. Students will always be prepared if you use this advice.
