

# First Grade Supply List

Dear Parents/Guardians,

We will also continue to develop our socialization, fine motor and gross motor skills. Our learning will begin the very first week of school, so please make sure your child comes to school on the first day with the necessary supplies.

## Necessary School Supplies (labeled with your child's name):

3 boxes of Crayola crayons (24 count)

1 pair of children's scissors

10 Elmer's glue sticks

1 bottle of Elmer's glue

1 plastic 2-pocket folder

1 Mead Primary Composition notebook Wide Ruled Gr.K-2... The notebook will have the type of lines and spaces used to print in K-2. \*These can be found at local Office Supply stores or on Amazon. If possible, please purchase the one with the white drawing box at the top of each page.

2 marble composition notebook (wide ruled)

1 smock (can be an oversized tee-shirt)

1 plastic supply box

2 containers of Play Doh brand Play Doh

2 containers of disinfecting wipes

1 box of tissues

Bring the following according to the first letter of your child's last name:

A-L... 1 package of napkins

M-Z... 1 package of baby wipes
