Welcome to Kindergarten! I cannot wait to begin working with your child. Kindergarten is a very busy year of growth and development, both socially and academically. We will work on foundational learning in all subject areas due to both diocesan and next generation/common core standards, as well as develop our socialization, fine motor and gross motor skills. Our learning will begin the very first week of school, so **please make sure your child comes to school on the first day with the necessary supplies.**

Necessary School Supplies (labeled with your child's name):

- 1 box of Crayola crayons (24 count)
- 1 pair of children's scissors
- 10 Elmer's glue sticks
- 1 plastic 2-pocket folder
- 1 Mead Primary Composition notebook Wide Ruled Gr.K-2... The notebook will have the type of lines and spaces used to print in Kindergarten. *These can be found at local Office Supply stores or on Amazon.
- 1 marble composition notebook (wide ruled)
- 1 plastic pencil box
- 1 smock (can be an oversized tee-shirt)
- 1 **X-Large** soft book cover
- 1 container of Play Doh brand Play Doh
- 1 package of napkins
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 complete change of clothes in a baggie labeled with your child's name
