1 plastic 2-pocket folder

1 Mead Primary Composition notebook Wide Ruled Gr.K-2... The notebook will have the type of lines and spaces used to print in Kindergarten. \*These can be found at local Office Supply stores or on Amazon.

1 marble composition notebook (wide ruled)

1 plastic pencil box

1 smock (can be an oversized tee-shirt)

1 X-Large soft book cover

1 container of Play Doh brand Play Doh

1 package of napkins

1 box of tissues

1 complete change of clothes in a baggie labeled with your child's name

## Bring the following according to the first letter of your child's last name:

A-L... 1 roll of paper towels

M-Z... 1 box of Ziploc snack size bags

1 package of baby wipes

1 box of Crayola markers (wide)
